Sub: - **Granting of full marks for the questions with multiple correct answers in the JTO LICE held on 26-05-2019 - req.**

Ref: - **BSNLEU letter no.BSNLEU/526 (JTO) dated 12.05.2020.**

With reference to the above cited letter, we would like to once again draw your kind attention to the following.

BSNLEU is continuously demanding that, relaxation should be given for reviewing the results of the failed candidates of the JTO LICE held on 26.05.2019.

In our earlier correspondences, as well as in the discussions held with your good self, we have already brought to your kind notice that, there were 10 questions with multiple correct answers in the question paper for the JTO LICE, held on 26.05.2019. We have demanded that, full marks should be given to the candidates, for all these 10 questions. This demand is raised from the premise that, the students have given the right answers to the questions, hence they deserve full marks to be given for those questions.

However, we were told by the Management that, according to the existing SOP, full marks could not be given. We were also told by the Management that, any change to be made in the SOP, can be made applicable only for the JTO LICES to be held in future, and that it could not be made applicable to the JTO LICE held on 26.05.2019.

This issue was thoroughly discussed in the meeting held between the Director (HR) and BSNLEU on 21.01.2020. In that meeting the Director (HR) was kind enough to hint about granting some relaxation to the failed candidates.

After the above mentioned discussions, we have already approached your goodself many times, requesting to grant relaxation to the failed candidates. The candidates who have narrowly failed in the JTO LICE held on 26.05.2019, are eagerly awaiting some relief, to be announced by the Corporate Office.

In view of the foregoing, we once again request you to kindly look into this matter and to consider our demand at the earliest, for which we shall be very grateful.
